3 24-08-2021 Heard the parties through virtual court proceedings.

Vide order dated 26.07.2021, report was called for from the court of learned A.D.J.- 8th, Saran at Chapra in S.Tr. No. 572 of 2019 regarding stage of trial in the present case which is received and tagged as Flag “R” to this petition.

In compliance thereof, a report dated 02.08.2021 sent by the Additional District Judge 7th, Saran at Chapra has been received and at Flag “R” to this application. Learned Judge, apart from the other facts, has stated that two witnesses have been examined in the present case but the cross-examination of the third witness is still pending.

Considering the facts aforesaid, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The prayer for bail of the petitioner is rejected.

However, the learned Trial Court is directed to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible preferably within six months



from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order and S.P.,
Saran at Chapra is directed to ensure production of the witnesses in
the case on each and every date fixed without fail.

If the trial is not concluded within the stipulated period, as
aforesaid, the petitioner would be at liberty to renew his prayer for
bail.
