Petitioner seeks bail in Cheriya Bariyarpur PS Case

No. 180 of 2019, registered under Section 30(a) of Bihar



Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

4491.9 litres of illicit liquor is alleged to have been recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. His name transpired in the confessional statement of co-accused Prince Kumar. The alleged illicit liquor were recovered from a field of sugarcane where pickup van was parked. It is submitted that there being no criminal antecedent of the petitioner and no recovery from his possession, he deserves bail. Petitioner is in custody since 09.12.2020.

Learned APP has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the rival submissions as also the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. Let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Begusarai in Cheria Bariyarpur PS Case No. 180 of 2019, subject to the following conditions:-

(i) That one of the bailors will be a close relative of the petitioner who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as



to how he is related with the petitioner. The bailor will also undertake to inform the Court if there is any change in the address of the petitioner.

(ii) That the petitioner will be well represented on each date and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail bond will be liable to be cancelled.
