learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No. 2532© of 2017 registered under
Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Further he submits that earlier on
21.06.2016, an informatory petition (Annexure-3) was filed by
the petitioner in the Court of C.J.M., Barh, Patna against the
complainant and her family members stating that the
complainant does not want to live with her husband.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M.-VIII, Patna in connection with Complaint Case No. 2532(c) of 2017, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
