7 06-04-2021 Heard the parties in virtual Court proceeding.

Let the defects, if any, be removed within two weeks
of the start of the physical Court.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No.1607C of 2010, registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 376/323 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Allegation is that the petitioner ravished to the
complainant.

Submission is that for some trivial dispute false case
has been lodged.

Considering the nature of allegation and the fact that



the petitioner has approached the Court after long delay, in my view, this is not a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail. Hence, the prayer for anticipatory bail is refused. However, in the event of surrender of the petitioner, the prayer for regular bail shall be disposed of without being prejudiced by the order of this Court.
