learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Parsha P.S. Case No. 27 of 2020 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 354B, 504/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.
