ORAL ORDER

3 26-10-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Buxar (Town) P.S. Case No. 399 of 2020 registered under Sections 341, 323, 419, 420, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. In the instant case, first information report is lodged after lapse of four years of the alleged occurrence. Further he contended that petitioners have



no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of C.J.M., Buxar in connection with Buxar (Town) P.S. Case No. 399 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
