ORAL ORDER

2 20-07-2021 Let the defects, if any, be removed within four weeks of the start of the physical Court.

Heard the parties in virtual Court.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the offence punishable under Sections 401 and 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

Another co-accused was allegedly apprehended along with a stolen motorcycle. Allegation against the petitioner is that he was pillion rider and fled away from there. Petitioner has stated on oath that he has got no criminal antecedent. Petitioner is in custody since 29.09.2020. Investigation of the case is already complete.

Considering the facts aforesaid, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of



Rs.20000/- (Twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Bagaha P.S. Case No. 515 of 2020, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
