2 21-12-2021 Heard Mr. Prabhakar Kumar, learned Advocate for the petitioners and Mr. Mohammad Sufiyan, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in anticipation of their arrest in connection with Gogri P.S. Case No. 236 of 2020 dated 26.06.2020 instituted for the offences under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 504, 506, 307, 308, 467, 468, 420, 385, 387 and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Approximately 500 to 600 persons including the petitioners who have been named along with 29 other persons are alleged to have made attempts at usurping a plot of land measuring 18 acres. There is no specific accusation against the



petitioners. The Court has also taken note of the fact that no body has been injured in the occurrence.

Regard being had to the general nature of accusation where several persons have been made accused and taking into account the gender of the petitioners they are directed to be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, on their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Khagaria, in connection with Gogri P.S. Case No. 236 of 2020 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code.
