2 23-11-2021 Let the defect (s) be removed within two weeks of

the complete start of the physical Court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 272,273 of
the Indian Penal Code as well as 30(a),38(1)of Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act.

Submission is that recovery of liquor is alleged from
behind the house of co-accused. The place of recovery is
accessible by anyone. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

Since no direct material is there against the petitioner,
let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or
surrender before the court below within a period of thirty days



from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000 (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Katra P.S.Case No.266 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the learned Trial Court.
