5 12-03-2021 The present writ petition has been filed for quashing

the order of transfer dated 02.12.2019 issued by the respondent

No. 5 i.e. the Deputy Development Commissioner cum Chief Executive

Officer, District Board, Patna whereby and where-under the services

of the petitioner has been transferred from Patna District to Dak

Bungalow, Bakhtiyarpur.

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner

submits that the said transfer order dated 02.12.2019 has already

been stayed by the Chairman of the Zila Parishad, Patna by her

order dated 17.12.2019.
