Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-



That the present writ application is being filed on behalf of the petitioner above named for setting aside the order contained in memo no. 3575 dated 20.07.2018 passed by Learned Sub Divisional Officer, Bhabhua, by which he has cancelled petitioner's PDS license being license no. 47/2016 and also for quashing the order dated 11.12.2020 passed in Supply Appeal No. 10/2019 by the learned Collector-cum-District Magistrate, Kaimur at Bhabhua by which the learned Collector, Kaimur was pleased to dismissed the statutory appeal and affirmed the order of the learned S.D.O., Bhabhua dated 20.07.2018.

After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to prefer revision before the appropriate authority.

Prayer allowed.

He may do so within a period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the State states that if any such revision is preferred by the petitioner within the aforesaid period, limitation shall not come in the way and the revision shall be heard on merits, to be decided within a period of three months from the date of its filing.

We only hope and expect the appropriate authority to consider and decide the revision on its own merit and with reasonable dispatch.



We clarify that we have not expressed any opinion on facts and law. All issues are left open.

Learned counsel for the parties undertake not to take any unnecessary adjournment in such proceedings.

The present petition stands disposed of with the liberty aforesaid.
