ORAL ORDER

3 02-12-2021 Heard the parties.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

From a two wheeler standing in the name of brother of the petitioner, liquor was recovered and co-accused-Chhotu Singh was apprehended.

Submission is that the father of the petitioner had given the said motorcycle to Chhotu Singh to bring medicines for his ailing mother. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

Considering lack of direct material against the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on



bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000 (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Mairwa P.S.Case No.421 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
