The petitioner seeks bail in connection with N.D.P.S.

Case No. 66 of 2020, arising out of Sadar P.S. Case No. 443 of

2020 registered for offence punishable under Sections 20/ 22 of

the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985

(N.D.P.S.).

The allegation is regarding recovery of 150 gm of

Charas from the possession of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the

petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the

present case. He further submits that apart from the present case

petitioner has been made accused in four other cases. He further

states that from the impugned order it reflects that petitioner is



in custody since 30th September, 2020.

Per contra, learned APP for the State vehemently opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner and taking into account the material available on record as also considering the stringent provision of Section 37 of the NDPS Act, 1985 and further taking into account the commercial quantity of Charas, which has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner, I do not deem it fit and proper to allow the petitioner the privilege of bail, hence the present petition stands dismissed.
