2 02-07-2021 Let the defects be removed within four weeks after
start of the physical Court.

The matter has been taken up through virtual Court
proceeding.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation is of recovery of liquor from a four
wheeler. Petitioner has stated on oath that he has got no criminal
antecedent. Petitioner is in custody since 01.12.2020.
Investigation of the case against the petitioner is already
complete.



Considering the facts aforesaid, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Angarghat Police Station Case No. 94 of 2020, Computer Registration No. 1250 of 2020, subject to the following conditions:-

(a) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the learned court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(b) Both the bailors shall be resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.
