2 16-04-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State through virtual mode.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to
remove the defects, as pointed out by the Office, within a period
of four weeks.

A supplementary affidavit has been filed on behalf of
the petitioner. The same be kept on record.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution case, in short, is that 120 liters wine is
recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
there is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against



the petitioner. It is alleged that 120 liters wine is recovered from the Scooty in question. The Scooty in question does not belong to the petitioner. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner had no knowledge regarding the alleged incident. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R./complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Patna in connection with Punpun P.S. Case No. 133/2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
