Heard both parties.

The petitioner seeks bail in Begusarai Muffasil P.S.

Case No. 343 of 2020, registered for the offence punishable

under Sections 392/411 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, petitioner along with two

other co-accused looted away the Scorpio vehicle and two

mobile phones of the informant.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that

petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. There is

general and omnibus allegation against this petitioner and his

implication is merely on suspicion. No vehicle or any looted



article has been recovered from possession of this petitioner. Similarly situated co-accused have been granted bail by different Benches of this Court vide order dated 12.03.2021 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 39570 of 2020 and dated 22.02.2021 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 39980 of 2020. Petitioner is in custody since 11.07.2020. Chargesheet has already been submitted.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that similarly situated co-accused have been granted bail by this Court, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Begusarai in connection with Begusarai Muffasil P.S. Case No. 343 of 2020, subject to following conditions:-

(i) The petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reasons, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the court below.

(ii) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty



to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
