Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

That this is an application for issuance of appropriate writ for release of the petitioner from Nari Niketan (Remand Home/After Care Home), Gaighat, P.S. Alamganj, District Patna, where she was sent by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-13, Motihari, East Champaran, vide the order dated 10.07.2020 passed in Chakiya PS Case No. 225 of 2020 dated 01.07.2020 registered under sections 363/366-A/34 of the Indian Penal Code on the basis of the written report of the petitioner's
