Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Lalganj P.S. Case No. 318
of 2020, registered for the offence punishable punishable under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

100 litres of country made liquor has been recovered
near the boundary wall of petitioner's house.

It is submitted that nothing has been recovered from
conscious possession of this petitioner. Recovery has been made
from open place which is accessible to general public.
Petitioner has got no concern with the recovered liquor and he is



in custody since 16.10.2020.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge II-cum-Excise Court, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Lalganj P.S. Case No. 318 of 2020 subject to following conditions:-

(i) The petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reasons, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the court below.

(ii) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
