2 04-09-2021 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video conferencing.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered under section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

As per allegation in the FIR, 21.3 litres of liquor was recovered from the house of the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that no incriminating article has been recovered from his possession or his house. He has been falsely implicated in the case because of his antecedent. He is in custody since 23.12.2020 and investigation in the case has concluded.

Heard learned APP for the State.



Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the antecedent of the petitioner under the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016, the Court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail and the application is rejected.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to renew his prayer for bail on completing one year in custody.
