The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Udwantnagar (Gajrajganj O.P.) P.S. Case No. 129 of 2019,
Excise Case No. 676 of 2019 registered for the offence

Excise Act, 2018.

In view of the fact that prima facie case under the
Excise Act, is made out against the petitioner, this application
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is not maintainable
in view of Full Bench decision of this Court rendered in the case



of Ram Vinay Yadav Vs. The State of Bihar reported in 2019 (2)
P.L.J.R. 1089 (F.B.).
