This modification application has been filed seeking
modification of the order dated 06.11.2020 passed in Cr. Misc.
No. 26904 of 2020 by which the prayer for anticipatory bail of
the petitioner has been allowed in connection with Hathauri P.S.
Case No. 242 of 2019.

Considering the averments made in the application,
the pandemic situation which is going on since the month of
March 2020 till date and the various kinds of hindrances coming



in the way of the litigants, this Court extends the period for submission of bail bond by four weeks from today.

If the petitioner surrenders and submits the bail bond within four weeks from today, he will be given benefit of order dated 06.11.2020 passed in Cri. Misc. No. 26904 of 2020. Rest of the order shall remain intact.

It is made clear that no further modification application will be entertained.
