This application for anticipatory bail arises out of
Ekangarsarai P.S. Case No. 82 of 2014 for the offence
punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 409, 120-B of the
Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is the widow of the deceased
employee. The offence alleged to have been committed by the
petitioner, in the opinion of this Court, is not possible,

Considering the aforesaid facts, this bail
application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his



her arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hilsa, Nalanda, in connection with Ekangarsarai P.S. Case No. 82 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
