ORAL ORDER

4 25-08-2021 Heard the parties through virtual court proceedings.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to remove the defects within three weeks of resumption of normal court proceeding. In the eventuality of non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office will place the matter before the Bench.

Earlier, vide order dated 09.11.2020, bail application of the petitioner was rejected in Cr. Misc. No. 24087 of 2020.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 354(A)(B), 379, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of the POCSO Act.

As per FIR, when the brother of the informant gone at the house of the petitioner, all the accused persons including the petitioner have assaulted him. It is further alleged that petitioner has fallen the informant and tried to outrage her modesty.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. By way of supplementary affidavit, learned counsel for the petitioner submits the informant in her statement under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C. has denied the allegation as alleged in the First Information Report. He submits that only to harass, humiliate and make pressure to settle the dispute to Rasta, informant brought this false case. He further submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail application and he is languishing in judicial custody since 07.05.2020.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and statement of the informant, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below/successor court where the case is pending in connection with Kawakole P.S. Case No. 132 of 2020.
