learned APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is expected

to honour his undertaking given in the instant case for

depositing the requisite court fee and to remove the

defects as pointed out by the office when called upon to

do so by the office.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in



a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307, 353, 222, 332, 269, 270, 290 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act and Section 3 of the Epidemic Disease Act.

It is alleged against all the accused persons including the petitioners that they have blocked the road in protest of arrest of the accused persons in connection with Nathnagara P.S. Case No. 439 of 2020 and when the informant along with other police personnel went to clear the road, they have been assaulted by lathi, danda, iron rod. The accused persons obstructed the informant in discharge of his official duties.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the accusation against the petitioners is general and omnibus. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let



the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, 1st, Bhagalpur in connection with Nathnagar P.S. Case No. 552 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
