Petitioners apprehend their arrest in Sonepur P.S. Case
No.814 of 2018 registered under Sections 498(A), 341, 323,
504, 506, 384 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners have committed no offence and have falsely been
implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that both
parties have compromised the case as has been stated in the
supplementary affidavit filed on behalf of the petitioners. The
