The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Sultanganj P.S. Case No. 199 of 2020 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341/323/307/504/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

In view of the submissions that both the parties have entered into a compromise, the present anticipatory bail application is allowed.

Accordingly, let the petitioner above named be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned



A.C.J.M. 1st, Bhagalpur, in connection with Sultanganj P.S. Case No. 199 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.

Before acceptance of the bail bonds, the Court below shall verify the genuineness of the compromise petition and if the compromise petition is found genuine, the bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted and if not found genuine, the bail bonds of the petitioner shall be rejected and the order granting anticipatory bail shall be treated to recalled.
