APP for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Barachatti (Mohanpur) P.S. Case No.140 of 2020 for offences under Sections 341, 323, 307 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code. Subsequently, Section 302 of the IPC has been added in this case.

In view of the fact that the deceased died after more than a week of the occurrence, it does not seem to be a case under Section 302 of the IPC and in view of the fact that the compromise between the parties has been arrived at, the



application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

Accordingly, let petitioners, above-named, in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sherghati, Gaya in connection with Barachatti (Mohanpur) P.S. Case No.140 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
