Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

As and when any such representation is received by the concerned respondent, the authority concerned is directed to consider the same and dispose it of expeditiously and preferably within a period of four months thereafter.
