On merit, prayer for bail was refused on 20.03.2020

vide order at Annexure-1.

It has been informed that charges have already been

framed during trial.



The learned trial Judge is directed to conclude the trial, preferably within nine months.

This order has been passed in presence of learned counsel for the informant, hence there is no reason that the informant would not appear before the trial Judge at the earliest.

Accordingly, this petition filed in connection with S.T.R. No. 86 of 2020 arising out of Mahila P.S. Case No. 55 of 2019 stands dismissed.
