This application has been filed by the petitioners for modification of order dated 28.02.2020 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 7794 of 2020, whereby petitioners were allowed anticipatory bail. One of the conditions therein was that they should surrender within four weeks from the date of the order. However, it is submitted that the petitioners due to the reasons mentioned in this application, could not surrender within the

aforesaid period and, thus, petitioner seeks extension of the time for surrender.
