1. That the present application is for issuance
of an appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/
directions towards commanding the Respondent Bank (Loan
disbursing authority) to calculate the petitioner's Education
Loan A/C no. 30978607703 as per Education Loan Scheme



in correct perspective in view of stipulated provision of the interest payable against the loan amount and after adjusting the subsidiary amount (Rs.1,57,658/-) , deposited/deducted amounts from the Pension Bank account of the petitioner's father namely Shankar Kumar, what amount is to be payable by the petitioner against the said Loan A/C in view of settlement of the Loan Account No. 30978607703. The first loan instalment of Rs. 53,460/- was granted on 04.12.2009 and all including total amount of Rs. 3,47,060/- was disbursed by the Bank under Education Loan whereas Rs. 4,10,000/- has been deposited by the petitioner against the said Loan Account. The petitioner has completed his course of Engineering in August, 2013. Further for relief/reliefs for which the petitioner is entitle under the facts and circumstances of the case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Permission granted.

The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

Interlocutory application, if any, shall also stand dismissed.
