ORAL ORDER

(The proceedings of the Court are being conducted through Video Conferencing and the
Advocates joined the proceedings through Video Conferencing from their residence.)

3 11-08-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 25(1-b)A,
26 of the Arms Act.

Allegation is recovery of two country made rifles, one
country made Katta and 24 empty cartridges with three Bindoli
from the house of petitioner which was kept in a box.

It has been submitted on behalf of petitioner that he is
innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioner
has no criminal antecedent and is in custody since 16.12.2020.

Considering that there is recovery of arms and

ammunition in huge quantity from the house of petitioner, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner. Accordingly the prayer for bail of the petitioner is rejected.

However, petitioner may renew his prayer for bail after framing of charge.
