3 22-10-2021 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video
conferencing.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant
of regular bail in a case registered under sections 30(a), 32(2)
and 32(3) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

As per the prosecution case, 165.375 litres of IMFL
was recovered from Toyota car being driven by this petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that no incriminating article has been recovered from his
possession or from the vehicle. He is in custody since
16.12.2020 and has no criminal antecedent. Chargesheet has
been submitted in the case.

Heard learned A.P.P. for the State.



Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts of the case together with the report of the S.P., Araria from which it transpires that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, the Court directs the petitioner to be enlarged on bail in connection with Sadar Anchal Excise Case no.61 of 2020 (Special Case no.1062 of 2020) on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/ (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge 2nd -cum-Special Judge (Excise), Araria.
