2 21-12-2021 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Amas P.S. Case No. 137 of 2018, for the offence punishable under Sections 420/409/120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R., subsequently an application was made and the petitioner is an accused in the case which were rejected by the District Cooperative Officer-cum-Certificate Officer, Gaya vide his order dated 02.07.2019. Thereafter, the petitioner has filed the present application for anticipatory bail apprehending his arrest in the case. He also submitted that the Chairman is already in custody and certificate proceeding for recovery of the amount are pending.

Considering the above submission, this application is



allowed.

Let the petitioner above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender within six weeks from today in the Court below be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M., Sherghati, (Gaya) or successor, arising out of Amas P.S. Case No. 137 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
