Counsel for the petitioners is directed to remove the



defect(s), as pointed out by the office, within a period of eight weeks.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Sathi P.S. case No.42 of 2020 registered under Sections 147, 148, 341, 323, 152, 188, 189, 332, 353, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that some persons have caught hold two persons on the suspicion of carrying beef by them and they have protested and blocked road and made slogans.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioners. The petitioners have falsely been implicated in the present case. As per the allegation, the petitioners along with others protested against the act of carrying beef. The names of the petitioners have transpired in this case on the basis of disclosure made by the local Chaukidar. Except for this, there is no other substantive evidence to suggest the implication of the petitioners in this case.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioners are named in the complaint case/F.I.R.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case,



the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, West Champaran at Bettiah in connection with Sathi P.S. case No.42 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
