ORAL ORDER

2 10-09-2021 Heard the parties in virtual Court proceeding.

Let the defects, if any, be removed within four weeks
of the start of the physical Court.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a)(c) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

Allegation is of recovery of liquor.

The petitioner has stated on oath that he has got no
criminal antecedent. Investigation of the case is already
complete.

Since this is first allegation against the petitioner
under the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, let the petitioner,
above named, who is in custody since 18.12.2020, be released



on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20000/- (Twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Excise Case No.1290 of 2020 with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
