APP for the State.

Counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove the
defect(s), as pointed out by the office, within a period of eight
weeks.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with S.Tr.
No.96/15 arising out of Sonebarsa P.S. case No.98/14 registered
under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, pending in the
court of 8th Additional Sessions Judge, Sitamarhi.

The earlier bail application of the petitioner was
rejected vide Annexure 1 to the present application taking into
account that the petitioner is the assailant.

A report was called for from the trial court. It has been
reported that out of six prosecution witnesses, five prosecution



witnesses have already been examined and only one witness is yet to be examined and the trial is expected to be concluded within a period of three months.

Considering the nature of accusation and the stage of the case, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. The same is rejected.

The Trial Court is directed to take all necessary steps to conclude the trial at the earliest.
