Heard both parties.

The petitioner seeks bail in Kotwali P.S. Case No. 419
of 2018, registered for the offence punishable under Sections
394 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, while the informant was
returning his home from his Scooty, on the way, three unknown
miscreants intercepted him and tried to snatch his Scooty. On
protest, the accused persons assaulted him with Katta on his
head, thereafter, informant fled away leaving his Scooty. All the
accused persons took away his Scooty.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that



petitioner is not named in the FIR. During course of investigation, petitioner has been remanded in this case from Kotwali PS Case No. 126 of 2019 and name of this petitioner has come on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Kumar Pallav. No looted article has been recovered from possession of this petitioner. No test identification parade has been held till date. Petitioner is in custody since 26.03.2019.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gaya in connection with Kotwali P.S. Case No. 419 of 2018, subject to following conditions:-

(i) The petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reasons, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the court below.

(ii) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
