Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered under sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code and section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

As per the prosecution case, 1292 litres of liquor is stated to have been recovered from a vehicle next to the house of the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case because of his antecedent. Neither he has any concern with the seized vehicle nor with the seized liquor. He is in custody since 22.12.2020 and chargesheet has been submitted in the case.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts of the case specially the petitioner having remained in custody for one year, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail in connection with Khanpur P.S. Case no. 221 of 2020 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Addl. Sessions Judge II-cum- Special Judge, Excise, Samastipur.
