The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Rupaspur P.S. Case No.380 of 2020 registered for offences under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

In view of the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is not the owner of the e-rickshaw and nothing has been recovered from his conscious possession, the application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

Accordingly, let petitioner, above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge of Excise, Patna in



connection with Rupaspur P.S. Case No.380 of 2020, subject to
the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
