“(i) For issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus to stay the Sale Notice dated 06.02.2021 by which a publication has been made for auction of the property of the petitioner on dated 17.03.2021.

(ii) For issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus to grant some more time to the petitioner to deposit the loan amount as per the demand of the respondent Bank.

(iii) For issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for a direction to the respondent



authority to grant subsidy to the petitioner in the light of his project “Vermi Compost Loan.

(iv) For any relief/reliefs if petitioner found entitled in the facts and circumstances of the present case.”
