2 09-12-2021 At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly submitted that the FIR in question has also been registered under the provisions of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, thus as per the procedure being followed, Criminal Appeal (S.J.) is required to be filed, challenging the order passed by the learned court below, hence he may be permitted to convert the present application into a Criminal Appeal (S.J.).
