3 27-09-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove the defect(s), as pointed out by the office, within a period of eight weeks.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in Parihar P.S. Case No. 07 of 2021 registered for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 379, 354, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, in the backdrop of land dispute, the petitioner along with other having variously armed came to the house of informant and assaulted his wife with Tengari as a result of which, she became senseless. The accused persons are also said to have outraged the modesty of informant's wife.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the



petitioner. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. The nature of injury is said to be simple. No offence u/S 307 of the Indian Penal Code is made out.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sitamarhi in connection with Parihar P.S. Case No. 07 of 2021 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
