Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for following reliefs:-

(i) For release of the confiscated Tata
Sumo Grand, vehicle of the petitioner, bearing
vehicle No. BR06PA-5402, Engine
No.483DLTC55AYY701142.

(ii) For grant of any other relief /
reliefs, which the petitioner is entitled to, in the
facts and circumstances of this case.”

Petitioner has approached this Court without exhausting
the statutory remedy of appeal against the impugned order, as
such, petitioner is granted liberty to avail the remedy of appeal



against the confiscation order passed by the Confiscating Authority- cum- District Magistrate, before the Appellate Authority and if any such appeal is filed within 4 weeks then appellate authority shall condone the delay in filing the appeal and shall decide the appeal on its own merit preferably within 8 weeks from the date of its filing.

During pendency of appeal, the confiscated property/ vehicle shall not be auction sold, if not already auction sold.

With aforesaid liberty, the writ petition is disposed of.
