ORAL ORDER

2 13-12-2021 Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to make necessary correction in the name of petitioner no. 2 in course of the day.

Prayer is allowed.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within four weeks after complete start of the physical Court.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 341, 323, 324, 354(B), 379, 504, 448 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Both sides are agnates. There is case and counter case.

Considering the general and omnibus nature of allegation as well as nature of offences alleged against the petitioners, who have got no criminal antecedent, let the



petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Arer Police Station Case No. 74 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the following conditions:-

(a) The petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the learned court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.

(b) Both the bailors shall be resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.

(c) The petitioners shall not leave the country without permission of the learned trial court.
