4 06-12-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in connection NDPS case no.
22/2018 arising out of Barachatti P.S. Case no. 444/2018
registered for the offence punishable under sections 18, 20 and
22 of the NDPS Act.

Allegation is of recovery of commercial quantity of
Ganga weighing 77 kg from dicky of a car which was being
driven by this petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is in custody since three and half years and till date,
charge has not been framed.

Learned APP opposes the prayer for bail and submits
that recovery is of commercial quantity of Ganga.



Considering the facts that recovery is of commercial quantity of Ganja, the court is not inclined to grant bail and accordingly, his prayer for bail is rejected. However, the learned court below will ensure that charges are framed expeditiously and trial, if possible, be concluded as expeditiously as possible.
