2 27-10-2021 Let the defects, if any, be removed within four weeks
of the start of the normal functioning of the Court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offences punishable under Sections 20/22/23 of the N.D.P.S.
Act.

16 Kilograms of Ganja was allegedly recovered from
co-accused Vikash Kumar. Vikash Kumar disclosed that
petitioner was also along with Vikash Kumar on the same
motorcycle. However, the petitioner managed escape. The
petitioner has stated on oath that he has got no criminal
antecedent. The petitioner is in custody since 14.10.2020.



Investigation of the case is already complete.

Considering the nature of material against the petitioner and completion of investigation, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20000/- (Twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with N.D.P.S. Case No.46 of 2020, arising out of Ghorashan (Jitna) P.S. Case No.383 of 2020 with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
