ORAL ORDER

2 29-09-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove the
defect(s), as pointed out by the office, within a period of eight
weeks.

The petitioner is apprehending her arrest in
connection with Excise case No.179C2 of 2020 registered under
Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution case, in short, is that 450 liters wine
is recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and there is no
allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the
petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in this



case. It is alleged that 450 liters wine is recovered from the pick up van. The petitioner is the owner of the said pick up van. Said pick up van is run as public carrier. The petitioner had no knowledge regarding the nature of goods booked by the transporter. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the complaint case/F.I.R.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional District and Sessions Judge II-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Jamui in connection with Excise case No.179C2 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
