ORAL ORDER

2 13-08-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State through virtual court proceedings.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to remove the defects, as pointed out by the office, within four weeks of resumption of normal court proceeding. In the eventuality of non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Kateya P.S. Case No.34 of 2021, registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he was apprehended along with his motorcycle and recovery of 41.200 liters of country made liquor has been made whereas other accused were also apprehended on the spot.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR. No such occurrence has ever taken place. He has been falsely implicated in this case due to high handedness of police. No incriminating article has been recovered from his conscious physical possession. He has no concern either with the seized liquor or any trade of liquor. Petitioner had argument with police during vehicle checking, as a result of which he has been implicated in excise case. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent, as mentioned in para-3 of the bail application and has been languishing in custody since 21.02.2021.

Petitioner is agreed to deposit a sum of Rs. 5000.00/- (Rupees Five Thousand) in the PM Cares fund, bearing Account No.2121PM20202, IFSC Code: SBIN 0000691, SWIFT Code: SBININBB104, State Bank of India, New Delhi Main Branch, UPI ID : pmcares@sbi.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below, where the case is pending, in connection with Kateya P.S. Case No.34 of 2021, with the following



conditions:-

(1) One of the bailors will be own close relative of the petitioner who will give on affidavit genealogy as to how he is relative to petitioner. The bailor will also undertake to inform the court if there is any change in the address of the petitioner.

(2) The petitioner shall not indulge himself in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial, failing which, his bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled by the learned court concerned.

The bail bond of the petitioner shall be accepted by the learned Court below on showing receipt of deposit of Rs.5,000.00/- (Rupees Five Thousand) in the PM Cares fund.
