Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

- i. For issuance of writ of certiorari for quashing the letter dated 29.11.2019 issued under the signature of Divisional Commercial manager E.R. Maldah by which the authority is saying that if, consent for conversion of book stall of petitioner into multipurpose ~~book~~ stall (M.P.S) may not be given then necessary action for termination of contract of license / closure of book stall may be taken.
- ii. For issuance of writ of mandamus Commanding the respondent authority not be enhance the license fee of the petitioner book stall.



- iii. For issuance of writ of Mandamus Commanding the respondent authority to open the sell counter of petitioner book stall in front of platform No. 1 and to allow hawker trolley to run on platform No.1 and 2 from one end to another for the user.
- iv. For issuance of writ of Mandamus Commanding the respondent authority to convert the book stall of petitioner into multipurpose stall but license fee may not be enhance keeping the benefit of petitioner as well of consumer both.
- v. For issuance of such other writ or order or direction which may deem fit and proper from ends of justice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to the original licence holder to approach the authority for redressal of the grievances, in accordance with law.

Permission granted.

The instant petition stands disposed of with the liberty aforesaid.

Interlocutory Application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
